Local Tennis Leagues is affiliated as a “nomadic club/place to play” with the LTA. To comply will LTA regulations all players who have signed up to play in a round agree to be bound by the following conditions

1. Defined terms

1.1 In the rules, unless the context requires otherwise:

“Disciplinary Code” means the disciplinary code of [the LTA] in force from time to time;

“[LTA]” means [LTA CLG] and its subsidiaries or such successor entity or entities as become(s) the governing body of the game of lawn tennis from time to time; [**Note: replace existing definition of the LTA with this definition.**]

“[member]” means a member of the [club/registered place to play];

“Rules” means the rules of [the LTA] as in force from time to time;

2. Conditions of playing in a round

2.1 Each player agrees as a condition of membership of a round:

(A) to be bound by and subject to these rules (as in force from time to time) ¹;

(B) to be bound by and subject to the Rules and the Disciplinary Code ².

2.2 Rule [2(1)] confers a benefit on [the LTA] and, subject to the remaining provisions of this rule, is intended to be enforceable by [the LTA] by virtue of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999. For the avoidance of doubt, the members do not intend that any term of these rules, apart from rule [2(1)], should be enforceable, by virtue of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999, by any person who is not a party to this agreement.

2.3 The management of Local Tennis leagues may terminate the membership of a round of any person, or impose any other sanction they determine to be appropriate, in connection with the breach of any condition of membership set out in this rule.

3. The Management of Local Tennis Leagues

Local Tennis Leagues to agree to be bound by and subject to these rules, the Rules and the Disciplinary Code, such agreement to contain an express acknowledgement that the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 applies and that [the LTA] and Local Tennis Leagues can enforce any breach at its option and in its sole discretion ³.

4. Coaches and players

Local Tennis Leagues agrees that all unlicensed and unregistered coaches and, so far as reasonably practicable, players and other persons using facilities of registered clubs and places to play will be required, as a condition of such use, to agree to be bound by and subject to these rules, the Rules and the Disciplinary Code, such agreement to contain an express acknowledgement that the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 applies and that [the LTA] and Local Tennis Leagues can enforce any breach at its option and in its sole discretion ⁴.
